ORDER:

- (1) **AMENDING NM IBR 3015-3 CHAPTER 13 - CONFIRMATION,**
- (2) **ABROGATING NM LBR 7005-1, SERVICE AND NOTICE BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION, AND**
- (3) **AMENDING NM LBR 9036-1, SERVICE AND NOTICE BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION**

It appears to the Court that the following changes to the local rules should be made without public notice and opportunity to comment, as authorized by 28 U.S.C. § 2071(e), due to the Court's conversion of its electronic filing system to the Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM-ECF) ^{System} *JG*.

In accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9029(a) and the March 19, 1992, Administrative Order of the United States District Court for the District of New Mexico (Misc. No. 84-0234; Addendum A to the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Mexico, October 1, 1996), IT IS ORDERED that, effective at 8:00 am on Tuesday, June 13, 2006:

1. New Mexico Interim Bankruptcy Rule 3015-3, Chapter 13 – Confirmation is amended to read as follows:

RULE 3015-3 CHAPTER 13 - CONFIRMATION

The hearing on confirmation of a chapter 13 plan will be scheduled by the Court. The date, time, and location of the hearing will appear in the notice of the section 341 meeting of creditors. The deadline for filing objections to confirmation of the plan shall be no fewer than five business days prior to the hearing on confirmation.

If a plan is filed with a chapter 13 petition in accordance with the Clerk's case opening instructions, the Clerk will give notice of the contents of the plan, notice of the deadline for filing objections to

confirmation of the plan, and notice of the hearing on confirmation in a time frame which ensures compliance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(b).

If a plan is not filed with a chapter 13 petition in accordance with the Clerk's case opening instructions, the debtor in a chapter 13 case shall give notice of the contents of the plan, notice of the deadline for filing objections to confirmation of the plan, and notice of the hearing on confirmation in a time frame which ensures compliance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(b).


2. NM LBR 7005-1, Service and Notice by Electronic Transmission, is abrogated.

3. NM LBR 9036-1, Service and Notice of Court-generated Documents by Electronic Transmission, is amended to read as follows:


NM LBR 9036-1 SERVICE AND NOTICE BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION

a. Service and Notice by the Clerk. Notice of entry of orders and judgments and service of certain papers by the clerk shall be by electronic transmission in accordance with guidelines established by the Court.

b. Service and Notice by Electronic Filers. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 5(b)(2)(D), the Court authorizes use of the notice transmission facilities of its case management and electronic filing system by registered electronic filers.
