

ORDER AUTHORIZING FILING
OF ENTRIES OF APPEARANCE BY FACSIMILE
TO FACILITATE IMMEDIATE ELECTRONIC FILING


New Mexico Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4(b) allows an attorney to file in a case electronically. NM LBR 5005-4(a) allows a party to file by facsimile to a court facsimile machine upon a showing of good cause, and with prior judicial approval.

Pursuant to NM LBR 5005-4(a) and 5005-4(b), the Court adopts the following guidelines which will allow attorneys holding an ACE (“Advanced Court Engineering”) log-in name and password to enter their appearance by facsimile in a case so they may immediately begin filing in that case electronically:

1. Attorneys holding an ACE log-in name and password who wish to begin electronically filing in an existing case with which they are not yet associated should submit an entry of appearance to the Clerk’s Office via facsimile, (505) 348-2473, using a form substantially identical to the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.
2. Upon receipt of the entry of appearance by facsimile, the Clerk’s Office will process the entry of appearance, associate the attorney with the case, and notify the attorney that he or she may begin filing in the case electronically.
3. An attorney submitting an entry of appearance via facsimile pursuant to this Order must certify in the entry of appearance that he or she intends to file in the case electronically.
