**OBJECTION TO HEWLETT-PACKARD'S APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE OF  
LATE FILED ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM**

Yvette J. Gonzales, the Chapter 7 trustee of Furr's Supermarkets, Inc. (the "Trustee"), objects to Hewlett-Packard's Application for Allowance of Late Filed Administrative Claim, docketed as #1456 (the "Application"), and states:

1. The Trustee objects to the Application because Hewlett-Packard, which got notice of the bar date for filing administrative claims, did not file a claim by the bar date.
2. Whether or not Hewlett-Packard's administrative claim continued to accrue, and the Trustee does not know at this point the facts of the matter, Hewlett-Packard should have filed an administrative claim for the amount that accrued by the bar date.
3. Litigation of the Application should be stayed until the Trustee is ready to process all administrative claims.
4. The Trustee objects to any order allowing payment of an administrative claim of Hewlett-Packard in any amount.
5. Apart from the late-filing issue, the Trustee objects to the amount and validity of Hewlett-Packard's claim.

WHEREFORE, the Trustee prays that the Application be denied, and for all other just and proper relief.


