

**ORDER ON HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY'S APPLICATION FOR  
ALLOWANCE OF LATE FILED ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM**


This matter came before the Court on the Application for Allowance of Late Filed Administrative Claim, Docket #1456 (the "Application"), filed by Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP"), and the objection thereto filed by Yvette J. Gonzales, the chapter 7 trustee (the "Trustee"), and the Court, being duly advised in the premises, ORDERS:

1. The Application is denied without prejudice.
2. When the Trustee begins the process of reviewing and objecting to administrative claims, she may object to HP's administrative claim in full or in part, for any reason, including without limitation the allegation that HP's claim was filed late.
3. If the Trustee objects to HP's administrative claim on any basis, in full or in part, HP may raise any and all issues in defense of its claim, including without limitation that the claim was not filed late or that the claim should be allowed in spite of its filing date.
