**ORDER GRANTING TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO ALLOW INCREASE OF SAGE  
ACCOUNTING'S HOURLY RATES**

This matter came before the Court upon the Trustee's Motion to Allow Increase of Sage Accounting's Hourly Rates, filed June 17, 2002 and docketed as #1704 (the "Motion") and the Court, having reviewed the Motion and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, FINDS:

A. On June 17, 2002, notice was given of the Motion, specifying a period of 20 days (plus 3 days based on service of the notice by mail, for a total of 23 days) to object thereto, in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rules 2002(a)(6) and 9006(f), to all persons on the limited mailing matrix maintained by the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court in connection with this case;


B. The notice was sufficient in the particular circumstances;

C. The objection deadline specified under the notice has expired, with no objections to the Motion having been filed;

D. The Motion and the relief requested therein comply with the requirements of Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules, and the local rules;

E. Entry of this order is appropriate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Sage Accounting may increase the hourly rate of Rachel Kefauver to \$135 per hour, plus gross receipts tax, for all work performed by Ms. Kefauver on or after June 17, 2002.


