MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

TO THE HONORABLE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY JUDGE:

HARREL L. DAVIS III, H. CHRISTOPHER MOTT and MICHAEL J. SHANE, attorneys with the law firm of Krafsur Gordon Mott P.C., counsel for JANUS FINANCIAL CORP. ("Janus") and EL PASO PROPERTIES CORP. ("EP Properties"), creditors and parties-in-interest herein, pursuant to Rule 5.2 of the Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Mexico, file this Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice, and in support would show the Court as follows:

1. On February 8, 2001, FURR'S SUPERMARKETS, INC. ("Debtor") filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
2. On December 19, 2001, the Debtor converted the Chapter 11 case to a case under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Trustee was appointed on or shortly after that date.
3. Janus and EP Properties are the landlords pursuant to a lease held by the Debtor at the time it filed for bankruptcy.
4. Janus has retained the services of Krafsur Gordon Mott P.C. ("KGM") to represent its interests in this bankruptcy case. KGM is located in El Paso, Texas. The warehouse the subject of the lease is located in El Paso, Texas.

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5. Movants, attorneys with the law firm of KGM, request the Court to admit them pro hac vice to represent Janus and EP Properties in this bankruptcy case. In support thereof, Movants represent to the Court that they are licensed to practice law in the State of Texas; they are members in good standing of the Bar of the State of Texas; and they have read and are familiar with the Local Bankruptcy Rules for the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Mexico.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Court is requested to admit Harrel L. Davis III, H. Christopher Mott and Michael J. Shane of the firm of Krafsur Gordon Mott P.C. to practice before the Court in this case on a pro hac vice basis, and for such other and further relief to which they may be justly entitled.


