**ORDER ADDING NEW MEXICO LIQUOR LICENSE 882 TO ORDER
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE SALE OF LIQUOR LICENSES**

This matter came before the Court on Yvette J. Gonzales, Chapter 7 Trustee's (the "Trustee's") Motion To Add New Mexico Liquor License 882 to Order Establishing Procedures for the Sale of Liquor Licenses (Docket No. 1852), filed September 23, 2002 (the "Motion"). The Court FINDS:

A. On September 23, 2002, the Court filed an order (Docket No. 1850) shortening the period to object to the Motion to eight (8) days plus three days if the notice is served by mail.

B. On September 24, 2002, the Trustee gave notice (the "Notice") of the Motion to all persons on the limited mailing matrix maintained for this chapter 7 case, as shown by the Notice filed September 24, 2002 (Docket No. 1856), which contains a proof of service.

C. The Notice specified a deadline of eight days, plus three days based on service of the Notice by mail, for a total of eleven days, in which to file objections to the Motion.

D. The Notice was sufficient and appropriate in the particular circumstances.


E. The objection deadline expired on October 7, 2002. No objections to the Motion were filed.

F. No further notice of the Motion or of this order is necessary in the particular circumstances, prior to entry of this order.

G. Entry of this order is appropriate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, as follows:


New Mexico Liquor License No. 882 ("License No. 882") is added to the definition of "License" under the Order Approving Agreement Regarding Sale Of Liquor Licenses, And Establishing Procedures For The Sale Of Liquor Licenses Free And Clear Of Liens And Payment Of Liquor Wholesalers And Certain Taxes, filed April 5, 2002 (the "Liquor License Sale Order"). Accordingly, the Trustee's sale of License No. 882 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Liquor License Sale Order is hereby approved.
