**ORDER APPROVING FEES OF MOUNCE,  
GREEN, MYERS, SAFI & GALATZAN, P.C.**

This matter came before the Court upon the fee application of Mounce, Green, Myers, Safi & Galatzan, P.C. ("Mounce, Green") for services rendered as special counsel to the debtor in possession, filed March 25, 2002, and a supplement to the fee application (entered on the docket as nos. 1627 and 1641) (together, the "Fee Application"). The Court, being sufficiently advised, FINDS:

A. On April 24, 2002, notice (the "Notice") was given of the Fee Application, specifying a period of twenty (20) days (plus 3 days because the notice was served by mail, for a total of 23 days) to object thereto, in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rules 2002(a)(6) and 9006(f), to all persons on the official limited mailing matrix maintained by the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court in connection with this case. The Notice, which entered on the docket as no. 1649, was sufficient.

B. The objection deadline specified in the Notice expired on May 17, 2002, with no objections to the Fee Application having been filed.

C. The Fee Application complies with the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 2016 and the local rules.

D. The compensation sought in the Fee Application for the period from September 21, 2001 through January 8, 2002 (the "Application Period") in the amount of \$6,032.23, consisting of \$5,848.50 for professional fees, and \$183.73 for reimbursable costs and expenses, is reasonable compensation for actual and necessary services that benefited the estate, and should be approved on a final basis.

E. Entry of this order is appropriate under Bankruptcy Code §§330(a), 503(b)(2) and 507(a)(1).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that:

1. Final approval is granted for, and Mounce, Green is allowed, as a priority, chapter 11 administrative expense under Bankruptcy Code §§503(b)(2) and 507(a)(1), compensation for Application Period in the amount of \$6,032.23, consisting of \$5,848.50 for professional fees, and \$183.73 for reimbursable costs and expenses.
