**ORDER APPROVING TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO AMEND EMPLOYMENT OF
MEYNERS & CO. AS ACCOUNTANTS FOR THE DEBTOR**

This matter came before the Court upon the Chapter 7 Trustee's (the "Trustee's") Motion to Amend Her Employment of Meyners & Co. as Accountants for the Trustee, filed December 18, 2002 and docketed as #1986 (the "Motion"). By the Motion, the Trustee sought Court approval to amend her employment of Meyners & Co. ("Meyners"), as accountants for the Trustee in this case, to include in the scope of work Meyners was to perform the preparation and filing for the estate of a certain 1998 Form -X, Amended U.S. Corporation Income Tax Return.

The Court FINDS:

A. On December 18, 2002, the Trustee filed the Motion;

B. On December 18, 2002, the Trustee gave notice of the Motion to all persons on the limited mailing matrix, as shown by the certificate of service on the notice (the "Notice");

C. The Notice was sufficient and appropriate in the particular circumstances;

D. The Notice specified a deadline of 20 days, plus three days based on service of the Notice by mail, for a total of 23 days, in which to file objections to the Motions;

E. The objection deadline expired on January 10, 2003, with no objections to the Motion having been filed;

F. No further notice of the Motion or of this order is necessary in the particular circumstances, prior to entry of this order;

G. The proposed amendment to the scope of Meyners' employment as accountants for the Trustee should be approved; and

H. Entry of this order is appropriate.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

1. The scope of the Trustee's employment of Meyners as her accountants, pursuant to Bankruptcy Code §327(a), is hereby amended to include the preparation and filing for the estate of a certain 1998 Form 1120-X, Amended U.S. Corporation Income Tax Return. The rates charged by billing professionals of Meyners shall be the same as set forth in the previous Court order approving the Trustee's

employment of Meyners, entered March 21, 2002 as docket #1616 (the "Original Order").

2. The Trustee's Motion is hereby approved effective as December 18, 2002.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Trustee's employment of Meyners shall be as set forth in the Original Order.


