**DISCLOSURE OF MICHAEL J. CAPLAN PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY
RULES 2014 AND 2016**

Michael J. Caplan hereby states, in connection with the motion of Yvette J. Gonzales, Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee") to retain him as an expert witness for the Trustee:

1. To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, after making reasonable inquiry, I have no connection with the Trustee, Furr's Supermarkets, Inc. ("Furr's"), Furr's creditors, any other party in interest in this case or their respective attorneys and accountants, the United States Trustee, or any person employed in the office of the United States Trustee.

2. The arrangement for compensating me, if the Court approves the Trustee's employment of me, is that the estate would pay me \$175 per hour, plus gross receipts tax, plus reimbursement of out-of-pocket costs, with a one-half day minimum for work that would take me away from my regular duties.

3. I have received no transfer, assignment, or pledge of property for post-petition services.

4. I have not shared or agreed to share with any other person or entity any compensation paid or to be paid by the Trustee in or in connection with this bankruptcy case.


