NOTICE OF DEADLINE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS TO SECOND INTERIM APPLICATION BY ATTORNEYS FOR CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE FOR ALLOWANCE AND PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION FOR THE PERIOD OF MAY 1, 2003 TO DECEMBER 31, 2003

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on February 6, 2004, the Attorneys for the Chapter 7 Trustee filed their "Second Interim Application by Attorneys For Chapter 7 Trustee for Allowance and Payment of Compensation for the Period of May 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003" (the "Application") in which the Attorneys for the Chapter 7 Trustee seek allowance and payment of compensation for services rendered and costs incurred between May 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003 (the "Application Period") in the total amount of \$556,646.05, consisting of \$502,701.50 for fees, \$24,724.89 for reimbursable costs and \$29,219.66 for gross receipts tax. As authorized by the Order Approving the Motion to Employ Davis & Pierce, P.C., the Chapter 7 Trustee has paid Attorneys invoices for services rendered in the Second Application Period in the total amount of \$421,085.07. A balance of \$135,560.98 was still owing during the Application Period. Attorneys have recovered \$3,561,537.51 for the estate, and another \$802,848.71 in settlements which have been agreed to but not yet paid. A copy of the Fee Application is on file with the Bankruptcy Court, and may be obtained from the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court. Copies of the original billing statements are available for inspection by any interested party in the Office of the Bankruptcy Court Clerk, 500 Gold Ave. SW, 10th Floor, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102.

The Application is on file with the Clerk of the Court, Tenth Floor, Dennis Chavez Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 500 Gold Avenue SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico, and is available for inspection by interested parties. **IF YOU OBJECT** to the Application, you must file the original and one copy of your written objection with the Clerk of the Court **ON OR BEFORE 20 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF MAILING OF THIS NOTICE** and you must deliver a copy to Davis & Pierce, P.C. (Chris W. Pierce, Esq.), P.O. Box. 6, Albuquerque, NM 87103. If objections are timely filed, a hearing to consider them will be held before the Honorable James S. Starzynski, United States Bankruptcy Judge in the Dennis Chavez Federal Building and United States Courthouse, Room 13102, 13th Floor, 500 Gold Avenue SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico on short notice to the Debtors and any objecting parties. If no objections are timely filed, the Court may consider entry of an Order granting the Application without further notice.
