**WHITMIRE DISTRIBUTION CORPORATION'S APPLICATION FOR  
ALLOWANCE OF ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM**

COME NOW Whitmire Distribution Corporation, d/b/a/ Cardinal Distribution (Cardinal Distribution), by and through its attorneys Baker & Hostetler LLP (Sherri B. Lazear) and Keleher & McLeod, P.A. (James C. Jacobsen), and pursuant to the Court's Order establishing, and the Debtor's Notice regarding, the Administrative Claims Bar Date, supplements its previous submissions, and reiterates that it holds, under the Court's Order Under 11 U.S.C. §§105(a), 503(b) and 546(c) Confirming Grant of Administrative Expense Status To Obligations Arising from Postpetition Delivery of Goods, Confirming Administrative Expense Treatment For Reclamation Claims, and Prohibiting Third Parties From Interfering with Delivery of Goods, entered February 9, 2001, an administrative priority claim in the amount of **One Million, Ninety-Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Sixty-Five and 29/100 Dollars (\$1,098,265.29)** on account of its reclamation claim. Cardinal Distribution states that it has previously complied with the provisions of the Court's Order Establishing Procedure for Resolving Reclamation Claims, has provided the Debtor with the information supporting the Administrative

Claim requested by the Debtor under the authority of that Order, and that the supporting documents are too voluminous to be attached to this pleading.

Cardinal Distribution further states that no objection to the amount of Cardinal Distribution's reclamation claim was made by the Debtor pursuant to the terms of Paragraph 4 of the Court's Order Establishing Procedure for Resolving Reclamation Claims, and that therefore Cardinal Distribution's Administrative Claim is to be allowed in the amount set forth herein.




