**TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO SHORTEN DEADLINE TO EIGHT DAYS TO
OBJECT TO MOTION TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY FREE AND CLEAR
OF LIENS AND INTERESTS, AND FOR ORDER GRANTING THE TRUSTEE
ACCESS TO CERTAIN FORMER STORES**

Yvette J. Gonzales, the Chapter 7 Trustee appointed in the above-captioned bankruptcy case (the "Trustee"), moves the Court for an order shortening the deadline to object her Motion to Sell Personal Property Free and Clear of Liens and Interests, and for Order Granting the Trustee Access to Certain Former Stores, filed April 24, 2002, (the "Motion") to eight days, and in support hereof states:

1. On February 8, 2001 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition in this Court under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code.
2. By August 31, 2001, the Debtor closed its grocery stores and ceased operating as a retail grocery business.
3. On December 19, 2001, the case was converted to a Chapter 7 case, and the Trustee was appointed the Chapter 7 trustee.
4. On April 24, 2002, the Trustee filed the Motion.
5. Good cause exists to shorten the objection deadline for the Motion to eight days. The matters raised in the Motion are routine, and any objections would be easy to prepare. It is important to the estate to complete some of the proposed auction sales set out in the Motion quickly, to avoid any potential chapter 7 administrative claim.

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WHEREFORE, Debtor moves the Court for an order shortening the deadline for objections to the Motion be to eight days plus three days for mailing, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems proper.


