**DEBTOR'S MOTION TO SHORTEN DEADLINE TO TEN DAYS FOR OBJECTIONS  
TO MOTION TO APPROVE WIND-DOWN BUDGET AND RELATED MATTERS**

Furr's Supermarkets, Inc., debtor in possession (the "Debtor"), moves the Court for an order shortening the deadline for objections to its Motion for (i) Approval of Wind-Down Budget, (ii) Approval of Cash Collateral Stipulation, (iii) Authority to Apply Funds and Operate in Accordance with the Wind-Down Budget Without Further Court Order, (iv) Approval of Employee Retention Plan, (v) an Order Directing Disbursement of Fleming Sale Proceeds and Other Debtor Property, (vi), Approving the Settlement of all Estate Claims Against the Secured Lenders, and (vii) Allowing Claims of Secured Lenders (the "Wind-Down Motion") to ten days, and in support states as follows:

1. On February 8, 2001 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition in this Court under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. The Debtor continues to operate its business and manage its properties as debtor-in-possession under Bankruptcy Code §§ 1107(a) and 1108.

2. On August 8, 2001, the Debtor filed the Wind-Down Motion.


3. Good cause exists to shorten the objection deadline to ten days. The Wind-Down Motion provides critical cash to the Debtor that the Debtor needs to operate from the date hereof until the Debtor's business operations are wound down. To assure retention of key employees and professionals, and the payment of the Debtor's current and projected future administrative expenses, the Wind-Down Motion must be heard as soon as possible.

4. The Debtor's secured lenders consent to the shortening of time requested in this motion.



WHEREFORE, Debtor moves the Court for an order shortening the deadline for objections to the Wind-Down Motion be to ten days plus three days for mailing, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems proper.


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
