**DEBTOR'S MOTION TO SHORTEN DEADLINE TO EIGHT DAYS TO
OBJECT TO MOTION TO REJECT CERTAIN UNEXPIRED REAL ESTATE
LEASES, SUBLEASES, AND EQUIPMENT LEASES**

Debtor in possession Furr's Supermarkets, Inc., (the "Debtor"), moves the Court for an order shortening the deadline to object to its Motion To Reject Certain Unexpired Real Estate Leases, Subleases, and Equipment Leases (the "Motion") to eight days, and in support states:

1. On February 8, 2001 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition in this Court under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. The Debtor continues to operate its business and manage its properties as debtor-in-possession under Bankruptcy Code §§ 1107(a) and 1108.

2. On August 17, 2001, the Debtor filed the Motion.


3. Good cause exists to shorten the objection deadline to eight days. The leases sought to be rejected cost the estate more than \$615,000 per month, plus the cost of the equipment leases for the stores in question. The matters raised in the Motion are routine, and any objection would be easy to prepare. The estate would benefit by an early rejection of the leases at issue.

WHEREFORE, Debtor moves the Court for an order shortening the deadline for objections to the Motion be to eight days plus three days for mailing, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems proper.

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
