**NOTICE OF DEADLINE TO OBJECT TO THE DEBTOR'S MOTION AUTHORIZING  
DEBTOR TO (a) IMPLEMENT EMPLOYEE RETENTION, SEVERANCE, AND SUCCESS  
BONUS PLANS; (b) ENTER INTO TRANSITION AGREEMENT WITH  
THOMAS DAHLEN; AND (c) ENTER INTO CONSULTING AGREEMENTS  
WITH GEORGE GOLLEHER AND GREG MAYS**

On March 26, 2001, Furr's Supermarkets, Inc. (the "Debtor") filed the above-referenced motion (the "Motion"). In the Motion, the Debtor requests that the Court authorize the Debtor to (a) implement an employee retention, severance, and success bonus plans for certain of its employees, (b) enter into a transition agreement with Thomas Dahlen, the Debtor's former President and CEO; and (c) enter into Consulting Agreements with George Golleher and Greg Mays, who will act as the Debtor's Non-Executive Chairman and Non-Executive Vice Chairman, respectively. Any party who objects to the Application must file its objection with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 421 Gold Ave. SW., Third Floor, Albuquerque, N.M. 87102 (or P.O. Box 546, Albuquerque, N.M. 87103), **WITHIN TWENTY DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF MAILING OF THIS NOTICE, PLUS THREE DAYS FOR MAIL FOR A TOTAL OF TWENTY-THREE DAYS (i.e., on or before April 18, 2001)**, and serve a copy of the objection on David T. Thuma, Jacobvitz, Thuma & Walker, P.C., 500 Marquette Ave., N.W., Suite 650, Albuquerque, N.M. 87102 and Richard Levin, Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP, 300 South Grand Avenue, Suite 3400 Los Angeles, California 90071-3144. If any objections are timely filed, a hearing will be held on notice only to Mr. Thuma, Mr. Levin, the U.S. Trustee, and objecting parties. If no objections are timely filed, an order granting the Application will be presented for entry without a hearing or further notice.
