**NOTICE OF OBJECTION DEADLINE FOR DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR ORDER
DETERMINING THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE NEW MEXICO ALCOHOL AND GAMING
DIVISION MAY NOT CONDITION APPROVAL OF THE TRANSFER OF DEBTOR'S
LIQUOR LICENSES UPON PAYMENT IN FULL TO LIQUOR WHOLESALERS**


On July 10, 2001, the Debtor and Debtor in Possession, Furr's Supermarkets, Inc., filed its Motion For Order Determining That The Director Of The New Mexico Alcohol And Gaming Division May Not Condition Approval Of The Transfer Of Debtor's Liquor Licenses Upon Payment In Full To Liquor Wholesalers (the "Motion"). A copy of the Motion is enclosed, and also is available for inspection and copying at the office of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 421 Gold SW, Third Floor, Albuquerque, NM 87102 (the mailing address is P.O. BOX 546, Albuquerque, NM 87103); and is expected to be available on the Court's website maintained for this case, www.nmcourt.fed.us/bkdoes.

By the Motion, the Debtor seeks an order determining that, notwithstanding §60-6B-3, NMSA 1978, or any other provision of the Liquor Control Act of the State of New Mexico, the Director (the "Director") of the New Mexico Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico may not condition his approval of the transfer of the licenses that permit Debtor to engage in the retail sale of alcoholic beverages in New Mexico (the "Liquor Licenses") to Fleming Companies, Inc., or its or its designees, upon payment in full to Desert Eagle Distributing Company, The New Mexico Beverage Company, Southern Wine & Spirits, National Distributing Company, Premier Distributing Co. and Joe G. Maloof & Co or any other liquor wholesalers. The Debtor further requests that the order direct the Director not to so condition approval of the transfer of the Liquor Licenses.

Desert Eagle Distributing Company, The New Mexico Beverage Company, Southern Wine & Spirits, National Distributing Company, Premier Distributing Co. and Joe G. Maloof & Co. (together the "Liquor Wholesalers"), by filing their objections to the motion to sell, filed June 1, 2001, already have objected to the relief sought by the Motion. **If the Director of the New Mexico Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico, or such Department and/or Division, object(s) to the Motion, he or it must file his or its objections with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 421 Gold SW, Third Floor, Albuquerque, NM 87102 (or P.O. Box 546, Albuquerque, NM 87103), on or before the date that is twenty (20) days after the date of mailing of this notice (plus three days based on service of this Notice by mail, for a total of 23 days), and serve a copy of the objection on counsel for the Debtor, Jacobvitz, Thuma & Walker P.C., 500 Marquette NW, Suite 650, Albuquerque, NM 87102.**

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
