

TO MOTION AUTHORIZING USE OF CASH COLLATERAL
FILED SEPTEMBER 6, 2001

Premier Distributing Company, Inc. hereby objects to the Order Arising Out Of Emergency Hearing to the extent it seeks to create a first priority or superpriority lien on the Debtor's liquor licenses or on any other assets of the Debtor as to which Premier Distributing Company Inc. may have a prior lien or claim.

Premier's understanding subsequent to the first day of the cash collateral hearing was that the Debtor did not intend to affect any claims or rights which Premier and other liquor wholesalers had, whether in specific liquor licenses, arising pursuant to subsequent court order, including those orders which granted 11 U.S.C. 507 priorities to vendors that continued to deliver product to the debtor, arising post-petition including as a right of set-off or recoupment.
