PETITION PACA TRUST CLAIM**



1. Furr's objects to the Motion because Furr's has no money with which to pay the alleged claim.
2. Furr's objects to the Motion because the amount claimed due and owing is, on information and belief, inaccurate.
3. To the extent movant has a valid PACA claim in an undisputed or otherwise allowed amount, Furr's has no objection to payment of the claim from the amounts being held for the benefit of the secured lenders in Furr's "blocked account," subject to either a Court order ordering the payment, or to the consent of the secured lenders to such payment.

WHEREFORE, Furr's prays that the Motion be denied to the extent set forth above, and for all other just and proper relief.


