
**ORDER GRANTING AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE TAX CLAIM  
OF NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF LABOR**

**THIS MATTER** having come before the Court upon the amended application filed November 5, 2001, by the New Mexico Department of Labor (NMDOL) for the allowance of an administrative tax claim for \$2,519.61, plus accruing interest, and as a continuing claim; the Court having reviewed the file and being sufficiently advised in the premises, notes that the Notice of Amended Application for Allowance, requiring a response within 20 days (and allowing an additional 3 days for mailing), was mailed November 5, 2001, and finds:

1. The debtor does not object to an entry of an order allowing NMDOL's claim as long as the amount will not have to be paid until further order of the Court.
2. The claim should be allowed in the initial amount of \$2,519.61, and the claim should be approved as a continuing claim should any future post-petition taxes become delinquent.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED** that the New Mexico Department of Labor's November 5, 2001, Amended Application for Allowance of Administrative Tax Claim be and hereby is approved as a Chapter 11 administrative tax claim in the initial amount of \$2,519.61, plus accruing interest at 12% per annum; but the sums due will not be paid until further order of the Court.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Chapter 11 administrative tax claim of the New Mexico Department of Labor be and hereby is approved, and is allowed as a continuing claim should any future tax delinquencies occur during the administration of this case. The claim shall be paid upon further order of the court.
