

**ORDER CONTINUING EARLIER ORDER
LIMITING NOTICE OF CERTAIN MATTERS**

This order is entered at the request of the Chapter 7 Trustee, Yvette J. Gonzales (the "Trustee"), with the approval of the United States Trustee. On February 20, 2001, this Court entered an Order Limiting Notice of Certain Matters (Docket No. 97) while this case was pending under chapter 11. On December 19, 2001, the Court entered an Order of Conversion to Chapter 7 (Docket No. 1424), converting the chapter 11 case to a case under chapter 7 (the "Conversion"). Although the limited notice provisions of the Order Limiting Notice continue to apply to notices given after the Conversion absent entry of this order, the Trustee has requested entry of this order so parties may rely on an order entered in the ~~chapter 7 case~~ when giving notice to the persons on the Limited Mailing List maintained in connection with this case. Having determined that entry of this order is appropriate, without notice, it is hereby

ORDERED that unless this Court orders otherwise, except where the Court specifically orders notice to all creditors and other parties in interest, all parties in interest (including the Chapter 7 Trustee) may limit notice to those persons on the Limited Mailing List of matters (i) of which notice otherwise would be given to all creditors and other parties in interest and (ii) of which the Bankruptcy Code and Rules authorize the Court to limit

notice. The Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court for this District shall continue to maintain the Limited Mailing List, adding thereto additional persons to be included on such list pursuant to the terms of the Order Limiting Notice. This Order is effective as of the date of the Conversion.
