Order Allowing Debtor's Counsel to Withdraw


On January 16, 2002, Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP ("Skadden, Arps") filed its "Motion to Withdraw as Counsel for the Debtor" (the "Motion"). On January 14, 2002, Skadden, Arps served notice of the Motion, and the deadline for objections, on (i) the Office of the United States Trustee; (ii) the chapter 7 trustee; (iii) counsel to the Debtor's postpetition lenders; and (iv) counsel to the former unsecured creditors committee.

Objections to the Motion were due on January 29, 2002. No timely objections were filed.

The Court has reviewed the Motion and is familiar with the issues raised in this matter. Based thereon, and on the record in this case, and

sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is ORDERED
that

- a. The motion is GRANTED;
- b. Skadden, Arps' withdrawal as counsel for the Debtor is approved, effective immediately.


