**ORDER CONTINUING HEARING ON MOTION AS IT RELATES TO  
EMPLOYEE RETENTION, SEVERANCE AND SUCCESS BONUS PLANS**


This matter came before the Court on the Debtor and Debtor in Possession's, Furr's Supermarkets, Inc.'s ("Debtor's"), Motion to Continue Hearing on Portion of Motion Relating to Employee Retention, Severance and Success Bonus Plans, filed May 4, 2001 (the "Motion"). The Court having considered the Motion, having noted that it is not opposed by the parties specified below who approved this order, and having determined that the relief set forth below should be granted, it is hereby

ORDERED as follows:

1. On March 25, 2001, the Debtor filed a Motion for Order Authorizing Debtor to (a) Implement Employee Retention, Severance and Success Bonus Plans; (b) Enter Into Transition Agreement with Thomas Dahlen; and (c) Enter Into Consulting Agreements with George Golleher and Greg Mays (the "3-25-01 Motion"). The portion of the 3-25-01 Motion that seeks approval of employee retention, severance and success bonus plans is hereby continued, and the pre-hearing schedule as it relates thereto is hereby vacated (such pre-hearing schedule was set forth in the Order Resulting From Preliminary Hearings On (a) Motion Relating to Employee Retention, Severance and

Success Bonus Plans, Transition Agreement, and Consulting Agreements and (b) Solomon Retention Application, filed May 2, 2001).

2. This order does not affect the remainder of the 3-25-01 Motion (which seeks approval of a transition agreement with Tom Dahlen and agreements with George Golleher and Greg Mays).


