**ORDER SHORTENING TIME TO OBJECT TO DEBTOR'S MOTION TO  
APPROVE WIND-DOWN BUDGET AND RELATED MATTERS**

This matter came before the Court upon Debtor in Possession Furr's Supermarkets, Inc.'s (the "Debtor's") Motion for (i) Approval of Wind-Down Budget, (ii) Approval of Cash Collateral Stipulation, (iii) Authority to Apply Funds and Operate in Accordance with the Wind-Down Budget Without Further Court Order, (iv) Approval of Employee Retention Plan, (v) an Order Directing Disbursement of Fleming Sale Proceeds and Other Debtor Property, (vi), Approving the Settlement of all Estate Claims Against the Secured Lenders, and (vii) Allowing Claims of Secured Lenders (the "Wind-Down Motion") and the Court FINDS that (a) the Debtor commenced this case on February 8, 2001; (b) Debtor has retained possession of its assets, as debtor-in-possession, and is continuing to operate its business; (c) On August 10, 2001, the Debtor filed the Wind-Down Motion; (e) an ten-day objection deadline to the Motion (plus three days for mailing) is appropriate in the particular circumstances; (f) good cause exists for the entry of this Order shortening the objection deadline.


The Court therefore ORDERS that the deadline for objections to the Motion is and shall be ten days, plus three for mailing, from the date the notice of the Motion is mailed.
