RULE 2019 STATEMENT OF ATTORNEY FOR MORE THAN ONE CREDITOR

Hisey & Cadigan, P.C. (Michael J. Cadigan) as attorney for creditors of Furr's Supermarkets, Inc., the above named debtor, makes the following statement pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2019.

1. I am attorney for the creditors whose names, addresses, the nature and amounts of whose claims and the times of acquisition therefor, except as to claims alleged to have been acquired more than one year prior to the filing of said petition are as follows:

- a. New Mexico Beverage Company, 701 Comanche Rd, NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87107, claim for unpaid invoices and returned checks relating to sales of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages in the amount of approximately \$913,124.55. The claim was acquired at various times in the past year. The claim is partly secured by a superpriority lien on Debtor's liquor licenses.
- b. Southern Wine & Spirits of New Mexico, Inc., 1601 Commercial NE, Albuquerque, NM 87102, claim for unpaid invoices relating to sales of alcoholic beverages in the amount of approximately \$1,300,363.80. The

claim was acquired at various times in the past year. The claim is partly secured by a superpriority lien on Debtor's liquor licenses.


- c. National Distributing Company, Inc., 5920 Office Blvd. NE, Albuquerque, NM 87102, claim for unpaid invoices relating to sales of alcoholic beverages in the amount of approximately \$1,222,816.60. The claim was acquired at various times in the past year. The claim is partly secured by a superpriority lien on Debtor's liquor licenses.
- d. Personnel Research, Inc. , 6301 Indian School Rd. NE. Suite 602, claim for unpaid invoices relating to contract pharmacist services in the amount of approximately \$27,012.28. The claim was acquired at various times in the past year.
- e. RRAM Liquidating Trust, 1201 Georgia NE, Albuquerque, NM 87110, claim for unpaid invoices relating to sales of alcoholic beverages in the amount of \$6524.17. The claim was acquired at various times in the past two years. The claim is secured by a superpriority lien on Debtor's liquor licenses.
- f. Market Logistics, Inc., 990 Rogers Circle Suite 3, Boca Raton, Florida 33487, claim for unpaid invoices relating to sales of various food items, sundries and beverages in the amount of \$24,465.40. The claim was acquired at various times in the past year.
- g. Santa Fe Springs, Inc., 701 Comanche Rd, NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87107, unpaid invoices for sales of bottled water in the amount of approximately \$22,000.00. The claim was acquired within the past year.

2. The following are the facts and circumstances in connection with my employment by the persons named in the foregoing paragraph:
 - a. My firm has represented New Mexico Beverage generally for 19 years. When notice of this was given, New Mexico Beverage requested that our firm represent its interests in this case.
 - b. My firm has represented National Distributing Company for 5 years. When notice of this was given, National Distributing Company requested that our firm represent its interests in this case.
 - c. Management officials with Southern Wine & Spirits are business associates of management officials with National Distributing Company. National Distributing Company referred Southern Wine & Spirits to our firm to handle their secured claim in this case.
 - d. My firm has represented Personnel Research Management in a recent matter. When this case was filed they asked our firm to represent them in connection with the unsecured claim.
 - e. Principals of RRAM Liquidating Trust were referred to our firm by Southern Wine & Spirits.
 - f. Market Logistics, Inc. contacted my office and requested that we represent them in this action.
 - g. Santa Fe Springs was referred to my office by New Mexico Beverage Company. The principals of New Mexico Beverage Company and Santa Fe Springs are associated.

3. My firm has written engagement letters with some of the clients listed above. The letters are covered by the attorney-client privilege.
4. I do not own, nor have I ever owned any claim whatever against the debtor in this case, nor any equity securities of the debtor.


