**Supplement to Second Interim and Final Fee Application of

Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP ("Skadden, Arps")

submits this supplement to its second and final application (the "Final Application"),

dated November 2, 2001.

Skadden, Arps seeks allowance of 100% of any gross receipts or use tax that may be owing on the fees and expenses requested in the Final Application. Following its engagement as Debtor's counsel in this case, Skadden, Arps modified its computerized-time-records software to enable it to track work done by its members and employees while in the State of New Mexico and all expenses incurred during these trips to the State. Based on the records that Skadden, Arps has kept of the work performed in New Mexico and the expenses incurred in New Mexico, Skadden, Arps estimates that, if the Final Application is approved in full, \$5,410 in New Mexico gross receipts taxes would be due, based upon fees of \$101,256 and expenses of \$6,949 relating to work done in New Mexico.



WHEREFORE, Skadden, Arps respectfully requests that any Order approving the Final Application include the relief requested in this Supplement.


