**IMPLEMENTATION OF MANDATORY ELECTRONIC NOTICING**  
**– SEPTEMBER 24 DEADLINE FOR COURT TO RECEIVE REGISTRATION**

Thank you for your responses to our August 12, 2004, request for comments on mandatory electronic noticing. Most responses were positive; we believe that the problems suggested by other responses can be overcome.

The Court has determined to implement mandatory electronic noticing for "Court-generated documents" effective Friday, October 1, 2004. We enclose:

- (1) The administrative order which addresses local rules to effect the requirement;
- (2) Electronic Noticing Guidelines Pursuant to New Mexico Local Bankruptcy Rule 9036-1, which outline the procedure; and,
- (3) Form 80 A, for attorneys to complete and return to the clerk's office for receipt by Friday, September 24.

These items are also available from the Court's website, where you will find additional forms for special situations noted in the guidelines.
