**JURY INSTRUCTIONS, OBJECTIONS, AND FORM OF VERDICT
ARE DUE TO THE COURT AT THE PRETRIAL CONFERENCE.**

Non-Stock Jury Instructions

Counsel are to meet and confer any time prior to the Pretrial Conference and agree upon a set of non-stock jury instructions.

When the parties cannot agree on certain non-stock instructions, each party shall prepare a set of requested jury instructions, with citations, and provide opposing counsel with this set at least **five working days prior to the pretrial conference.**

All of the non-stock jury instructions and the objections thereto will be filed with the Clerk and **submitted to the Court at the Pretrial Conference.**

Stock Jury Instructions

These instructions are prepared by the Court and located on our website @ www.nmcourt.fed.us. Counsel should be prepared to advise the Court at the pretrial conference which instructions they will require (e.g., use of interrogatories, depositions, mortality tables, corporation as a party, etc.).

Form of Verdict

The parties should meet and confer on the form of verdict to be submitted to the Court with the jury instructions.

Submissions

It is each party's obligation to have a set of jury instructions filed with the Clerk's Office in addition to delivering a copy to chambers.
