which includes the following language:

Consistent with Judicial Conference policy, courts may, upon a showing of cause, exempt indigents, bankruptcy case trustees, individual researchers associated with educational institutions, courts, section 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organizations and pro bono ADR neutrals from payment of these fees.

Courts must find that parties from the classes of persons or entities listed above seeking exemption have demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information.

Any user granted an exemption agrees not to sell for profit the data obtained as a result. **Any transfer of data obtained as the result of a fee exemption is prohibited unless expressly authorized by the court.** Exemptions may be granted for a definite period of time and may be revoked at the discretion of the court granting the exemption.
