Procedures for Submitting Proposed Orders and Other Proposed Text/Documents

As outlined in the CM/ECF Administrative Procedures Manual, proposed orders should **not** be filed or submitted to the Clerk or Chambers unless otherwise required by the judge.

General Procedures

- When proposed orders are required by the assigned judge, the proposed orders should be submitted via email to the judge who is to sign the order.
- Email addresses and chambers-specific requirements for formatting proposed orders are available below and on the Court's website at www.nmcourt.fed.us.
- The proposed order text should be submitted either in the body of the email message or attached in a compatible word processing format document. The filer should NOT submit the proposed text in PDF format.
- The subject line of the email must include all of the following:
 - (1) the case number,
 - (2) the judge's initials,
 - (3) the docket number of the corresponding motion, and
 - (4) a very brief description of the proposed document.

Example: 06cv01234, MV, 10, Order Dismissing
- The document itself should be similarly named to convey the same information
Example: 06cv01234_MV_10_Order_Dismissing.rtf
- The following is a list of documents that may need to be both e-filed **and** submitted using the procedures listed above. If you have questions regarding these specific documents, please check with assigned judge for clarification.
 - Proposed Pretrial Order
 - Proposed Findings of Fact
 - Proposed Jury Instructions
 - Proposed Voir Dire
