16.1 Joint Status Report. [*Amended date*] A Joint Status Report form is available at the Clerk's office and on line. Following the FED. R. CIV. P.26(f) meet-and-confer conference, the parties must complete the Joint Status Report. The parties must file the completed Report at least five (5) calendar days before the scheduling conference, or as ordered by the Court if no scheduling conference is set. After the filing of the Joint Status Report, the Court will enter a notice of trial setting and a scheduling order setting all pretrial case management deadlines. Modification of deadlines in the Court's scheduling orders and trial notices, whether or not opposed, requires a showing of good cause and Court approval.
