R. CIV. P. 26~~ Following the FED. R. CIV. P.26(f) meet-and-confer conference. ~~A consolidated report, signed by the parties and with dates left blank, must be sent to the assigned Magistrate Judge,~~ the parties must complete the Joint Status Report. The parties must file the completed Report at least five (5) calendar days before the scheduling conference. ~~Any deadlines established in the Initial Pretrial Report will govern actions in pretrial matters once the report is entered, or as ordered by the Court.~~ Any modification of the deadlines if no scheduling conference is set. After the filing of the Joint Status Report, the Court will enter a notice of trial setting and a scheduling order setting all pretrial case management deadlines. Modification of deadlines in the Court's scheduling orders and trial notices, whether or not opposed, ~~will~~requires a showing of good cause and Court approval.
