ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


Pursuant to the authority of Section U.S.C. 3606 of Title 18 of the Federal Criminal Code and Rules, Arrest and Return of a Probationer. It is ordered that the following protocol for issuance of verbal warrants is hereby adopted in the United States District Court for the District of New Mexico:

1. Emergency Verbal Warrants will be requested from the Duty U.S. Magistrate Judge during non-working hours (5:00 PM to 8:00 AM & Weekends and Holidays), when there is an identified immediate risk of danger to the community.
2. The U. S. Probation Officer will contact the Duty Magistrate Judge on his/her home telephone or cell phone and provide the Magistrate Judge with the circumstances justifying the warrant. The U.S. Probation Officer may contact any other U.S. Magistrate Judge should the Duty Magistrate not be available.
3. Once the verbal warrant has been approved, the U.S. Probation Officer will contact the Duty U.S. Marshal and request the arrest of the defendant based on the Court's approval.
4. The next working day, immediately upon arrival to the office, the U.S. Probation Officer will prepare and submit Petition to Revoke Supervision and a request for a warrant to the assigned District Court Judge.
5. The U.S. Probation Officer will follow-up that same date with preparing a violation memorandum and revocation packet for the Court.


