ORDER

Before **BRISCOE**, Chief Judge; **KELLY, LUCERO, MURPHY, HARTZ, O'BRIEN, TYMKOVICH, GORSUCH, HOLMES**, and **MATHESON** Circuit Judges.

This matter is before the court to appoint a Federal Public Defender for the District of New Mexico. Mr. Stephen P. McCue, Federal Public Defender for the District of New Mexico, completed his third four-year term on July 22, 2011. His appointment was extended on July 23, 2011, until the earlier of 1) his reappointment; 2) the appointment of a successor; or 3) December 31, 2011.

Because Mr. McCue has served three terms, a non-competitive merit selection process was initiated in October of 2010. That process was established pursuant to this court's Policy for Reappointment of Federal Public Defenders. Mr. McCue reapplied for the position. Following a complete investigation, the merit selection committee recommended Mr. McCue for reappointment. Based on that recommendation, together with an independent review, the active judges of this court voted unanimously to appoint

Mr. McCue to another four-year term. This appointment will be effective August 8, 2011.
