ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**


With concurrence of all active Article III judges in the District, this Amended Administrative Order is entered for the Court:


IT IS ORDERED that as of June 14, 2004, all pleadings and papers filed on behalf of parties represented by the Federal Public Defender Organization or the United States Attorney in this District shall be filed electronically via ACE by those agencies.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon consideration, the following exceptions are approved by the Court: (a) documents or pleadings which require more than one signature; (b) documents or pleadings which require the signature of a third party; (c) initiating documents (i.e., complaints, warrants, indictments, etc); and (d) documents which are filed in open court.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any other exceptions must be approved by the Court.


