
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Administrative Order is entered for the Court,


IT IS ORDERED that as of June 14, 2004, all pleadings and papers filed on behalf of

comply with this order.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that exceptions may be granted upon consideration and




