

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


With the concurrence of all active Article III judges in the District, this Administrative Order is entered for the Court,

Attorneys presently enrolled with the court to receive notice electronically are not required to resubmit their preference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that exceptions may be granted upon consideration and approval of the Court.








