A Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) is a “charge account” arrangement between a buyer and a seller for recurring purchases of services. BPAs are not contracts and do not obligate government funds in any way. A contract occurs upon the placement of a call or referral from the Probation/Pretrial Services Office and the vendor’s acceptance of the

referral. Referrals will be rotated among all vendors placed on a particular BPA. BPAs are valid for a specific period of time, not to extend beyond the current fiscal year. The total of a BPA, including the exercise of two 12-month options, shall not exceed 36 months. BPAs will be issued to those vendors determined to be technically acceptable and offering the lowest cost to the Government, using the Evaluation Criteria established in Section M of the Request for Proposal.
